



HOW TO USE EXPERIENCE SCRIPTURE

EXPERIENCE SCRIPTURE resources are designed specifically to help readers engage with God's Word through reading and reflection. In addition to the included reading from Scripture, each day also provides a brief commentary on the day's passage. Students will also be prompted to do something experiential with the truth they just encountered, hopefully bridging the gap between "devotions" and everyday living.

When used strategically, a resource like this could have a powerful effect on your students. Consider using Experience Scripture in the following ways:

- 1 Pair Experience Scripture studies with large **group sermons**. When teaching through Proverbs or the life of Jesus, encourage your students to read *Experience the Wisdom of Proverbs* or *Experience the Gospel of Mark* throughout the series. This can reinforce the themes and takeaways of your weekly sermons while also challenging your students to engage with Scripture on their own.
- 2 Oftentimes, **small groups** are looking for something to do together when regular ministry programming takes a break (like in the summer or during Christmas break). Encourage your small groups to read through one of these resources together and meet weekly to talk about what they are learning.
- 3 **Retreats, summer camps, and mission trips** often produce students who are eager to take their next step in their relationship with Jesus. You can capitalize on the momentum from these experiences by providing a solid resource for students to engage with as they continue to grow after your event.
- 4 It is common for youth groups to give students **baptism gifts or 8th grade graduation gifts**. Experience Scripture would be a great addition to whatever gifts you give away during these occasions.
- 5 Perhaps the easiest way to partner together is simply recommending Experience Scripture resources to **your community** in your email newsletters, through your social media channels, or by including Experience Scripture on your website if you have a "recommendations" page. A simple recommendation can not only help your students but can also help **you** earn credibility and favor with the families in your church by showing your desire to partner with families as they disciple their kids.
