

Retention of Personal Information

We retain personal information for as long as reasonably necessary to fulfill the purposes for which it was collected, as described in our Privacy Notice, and in accordance with our internal record-keeping practices, unless a longer retention period is required or permitted by law.

Retention periods may vary depending on the type of information, the purpose for which it is processed, and the systems or platforms in which it is stored. Certain records, including financial, transactional, and operational records, may be retained for extended or indefinite periods where necessary to maintain accurate business records or comply with legal, accounting, tax, audit, or regulatory requirements.

Personal information may also be stored in backup or archival systems for limited periods in accordance with our data management and record-retention practices. Information contained in backups is subject to appropriate safeguards and is retained until the applicable backup lifecycle expires.

Personal information may be processed and stored in jurisdictions outside of an individual's country of residence, including in countries where data protection laws may differ. Regardless of where personal information is processed or stored, we apply this retention policy and appropriate safeguards in accordance with applicable law.

Some personal information may be processed or stored by third-party service providers or platforms on our behalf. These providers may retain personal information in accordance with their own retention policies and legal obligations.

When personal information is no longer needed for the purposes described above, we take reasonable steps to securely delete, de-identify, or anonymize it in accordance with applicable law.
