

The Many Names of Lod

Who is God except the LORD? Who but our God is a solid rock? God is my strong fortress, and he makes my way perfect. He makes me as surefooted as a deer, enabling me to stand on mountain heights. —2 SAMUEL 22:32-34

Over the years, I've noticed multiple sides to my husband. There's the childlike, fun-loving side—sort of like the character played by Tom Hanks in *Big*. There's the serious, strict side, which my kids see from time to time. There's the vulnerable side (he may or may not need tissues to watch *The Land Before Time*). There's the strong side (he can open any jar of pickles, carry big bags of water-softener salt to the basement, and kill spiders). There's the spiritual side (there's nothing like seeing your man pray with your children). And yet, just as I've experienced with Tim, I understand that my love for God is more full when I am aware that He's multifaceted.
